BALL CLUB is a new activity so feel free to give feedback and bring new ideas.

**Any physical activity has a downside. Ball games deal with throwing, catching – and sometimes getting hit by – various balls and equipment. Running, jumping, and playing require physical exertion and bring with them the risk of injury. Precautions for safety will always be taken but athletes need to pay attention to volunteers and know their limits.*
